"Local Tourist Attractions" is an international project engaging schools from Poland, Northern Ireland, England, Italy and Turkey, presenting values of tourist attractions of each participant's region: its location, cuisine, traditions, folk tales and legends as issues drawing tourists and visitors to these regions.

The topic area was designed to meet students' needs and arouse their interests. It establishes a great opportunity to assimilate new information in spontaneous and creative way and eventually, broaden their knowledge.

Moreover, the project touches the issue of diversity of European cultures and languages and shows its value.

This multicultural exchange is expected to stimulate the awareness of the national culture in perspective of European and world culture.

The working language used in the partnership is English so students practice and improve their language skills in authentic environment.

All participants may experience various techniques from exploring the area and working with a map, through talking to local people, cooking and dancing together to performing the folk stories and legends.

Finally, students can develop key competences and shape a future active European citizen sensitive for others' needs and open for different religions or ideologies.
